Elan valley visitor centre

Sample Walks

Pat recced 4 local walks

walk 1- circular from Elan valley visitor centre alongside reservoir then returning on other side of reservoir through wooded path - approx 7miles + a bit extra from CP to start of the walk walk 2 - walked to visitor centre from Rhayader along easy path then a cross country route back to Rhayader. Approx 9 miles but third of it was easy path.

walk 3 - a short local walk following Walking guide -1. approx 3 miles, with a bit of variety and a little up & down, but not hard at all

Walk 4 - good views so there was some uphill, but summit was only 530 ft. Approx 9 miles. A good day walk

Lynn & Heather recced a 5 mile walk from Rhayader, along mostly guiet roads, tracks & paths

Catering

<u>Breakfast</u> is included in cost of room. Tea / coffee; choice of cereals, fruit, yogurt (flavoured) & fruit juice. Cooked breakfast & toast prepared when ordered.

Dinner would most likely be in a local pub restaurant. Best to make a reservation.

Eating out options

Old swan tearoom 9-4pm not Tues. Cash only. Tested this and it was good

Lamb & flag - tested this twice. Ok menu and not too expensive - out door space beside restaurant, some under cover

Crown inn - was closed on Monday evening so didn't eat there. Outside courtyard at back Triangle Inn- no menu on website and didn't check it out, but great location for post walk drink Ty Morgan's cafe restaurant bar - tested this in afternoon after a walk - wouldn't be my first choice for coffee & cake, but a fair size inside & also has rear courtyard The Elan hotel

Journey time to Rhayader was approx 4 hours with a short stop, but could make a day of it.

Room options

2x twin en-suite rooms at £90 per night including breakfast

2x double en-suite rooms at £90 per night including breakfast

1x double room, with washbasin, with adjacent shared bathroom (good shower) at £70 per night including breakfast

1x single room, with washbasin, with shared bathroom, as above at £55 per night including breakfast
