Walk description / difficulty	Relatively easy walk at a steady, but not brisk, pace. Some gentle up/down hill . Would recommend walking boots / shoes Great views at times but also peaceful woodland and some footpaths & byways with high hedges, Option for short stop to visit St Lawrence church, Weston Patrick, approx 1 hour into walk & St Mary's church at end.
Terrain	Mostly footpaths, byways and quiet lanes. some paths muddy or covered in damp leaves. If concerned about slipping, bring walking poles.

Distance to start	9 miles - approx 25 minutes from Oakley
Where we are parking	At side of road outside St Mary's church. Room for 3 or 4 cars

Directions to start of walk	Head for A339 then turn off to left, just after driving below M3, SP Tunworth & Upton Grey
